

Application of Sanum Remedies in Vaporized Form via Nebulizers

Almost as Good as IV Injections

Most children and many adults in Australia are horrified of needles. A more attractive and nevertheless very effective alternative for many patients is therefore the application of Sanum remedies via a nebulizer, which is now extensively used in our clinic. It is also a great way to apply the Sanum remedies by the patients themselves at home.

Nebulizers – almost as good as IV injections

The systemic uptake of vaporized medication in the lungs has been well demonstrated in various clinical trials. It guarantees great efficacy, which comes close to an IV injection. Orthodox medicine uses this route of application mainly in patients with asthma and chronic obstructive airways disease. In acutely ill patients, where a quick IV access can't be established, it is the preferred form of application over IM or SC injections because the uptake is quicker and more effective.

Nebulizers and Sanum Remedies

Most of the Sanum remedies suitable for IV injection can be given via a nebulizer in the clinic, but so can most IV injectables. However, the oral drop form of the Sanum Isopathic Remedies, Immunobiological Remedies and Sanukehl Preparations contain the active ingredient in purified water only and not like other preparations ethanol or preservatives. This unique manufacturing process allows those remedies being applied via nebulizers as well. The oral drop form of Sanum Isopathic, Immunobiological and Sanukehl Remedies can so be taken by patients at home in a way almost as effective as having an IV injection.

The Choice of Nebulizer

There are many different makes of nebulizers for clinic and home use on the market, ranging from cheap air pressure driven ones to the more expensive ultrasonic vaporizers. Standard supply includes an adult mask, child mask and adult and child mouthpiece for inhalation.

We have great success with our patients using this method of application. Some patients have bought their own nebulizer for home use because they feel that this kind of application is superior to oral intake. Other patients ring in to specifically make an appointment to “have the nebulizer” because they feel “a cold coming on” or a bit “chesty” or “sinusy”.



The Right Choice of Sanum Remedies to be administered via a nebulizer

We prefer to test for the right combination of Sanum remedies to be administered via a nebulizer with kinesiology. All ampoules of the Sanum test kit of the isopathic, the immunobiological and Sanukehl range are placed in a bowl and picked out and tested on random so both, examiner and patient, do not know, which remedy is tested for. This guarantees a random blind element, which cannot be achieved by any other testing method. Combinations of suitable Sanum remedies are tested again in the same fashion until the strongest combination of 2 or 3 remedies is found.

Summary:

Nebulizer – the most effective way to administer the oral drop form of Sanum Isopathic, Immunobiological and Sanukehl Remedies. Almost as good as an IV injection.
